

Small changes that make a big difference

Are you already living in your dream home? Though many people would not answer 'yes', it might surprise you that most people are already pleased with most of their home.

and less. She wanted to move the cook top off of the island, add a range hood, and replace the upper cabinets with a set that went up to the ceiling.

Lavinia's daughter, an artist who has her studio in the house, wanted the range hood to blend in with the cabinetry. She designed a cabinet with an arch, as well as a backsplash. Mother and daughter chose the tiles, and provided a rough draft of their ideas. Lavinia is pleased and proud, "Shane was able to take what my daughter designed and did a beautiful job. Now it all fits."

The Melton Team's craftsmanship didn't end there. The lower cabinets are cherry, which can be hard to match. The company that made the originals didn't make upper cabinets large enough to go to the ceiling, which was Lavinia's plan. 

Without moving a wall, the kitchen workspace, above, was made more user-friendly by moving the cooktop from the island to an outside wall, and enlarging the island top to accommodate seating. All of the lower cabinets were reused (some were moved) in the redesign, which reduced the projects overall cost. The granite countertops - the most expensive single element of the new kitchen - combine with the black appliances to complement the cherry wood cabinetry, which will continue to deepen in color as they age.
